Pressure sensitive adhesive must be applied with a maximum of pressure in order to achieve maximum pressure level. The indicated level of performance will be reached after a bonding period of 24 HRS at 23 °C.

Storage and Shelf Life:

Clean and dry in a well ventilated area, preferably at a temperature between 0°C and 45°C. Stored under these conditions shelf life will be a minimum of 12 months.
